

CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLES

Your street's regular collection happens every other MONDAY.

*** Please place the container curbside no later than 6 am of the day of collection. ***

Collection will NOT take place on the following holidays:

- Christmas- Friday, 12/25/2009
- Good Friday- 4/2
- Labor Day- Monday, 9/6
- New Year's Day- Friday, 1/1/2010
- Memorial Day- Monday, 5/31
- Thanksgiving- Thursday, 11/25

After a holiday, the collection schedule for the remainder of the week shifts one day later than the usual day.



IMPORTANT FACTS

Think before you toss!

We hear many people proudly exclaim, "I recycle everything!" and while the motivation to waste less is great, the reality is that a lot of *trash* is getting mixed in with our recyclable materials. Remember, "When in doubt, throw it out!"

So what is recyclable?

Start off by looking at the pictures and lists on the lid of your cart. If you still have questions, visit our website or give us a call. Plus, read below to see how you can sign up for our free quarterly email newsletter.

It matters because...

Every non-recyclable item that ends up in a recycling cart or bin hurts the program. It costs the county more than \$40,000 a month to collect, transport, sort and dispose trash mixed in with recyclables. **More than 7% of what is collected in the curbside recycling program is trash that must be sorted out and thrown away. You can change this!**

We know that packaging can be confusing—especially plastics—and we're glad to help you "sort things out". Call or send us an email if you want to know whether something is recyclable or not. Or visit our website to see a list of the most common recycling mistakes: www.FrederickCountyMD.gov/oops!

Not all bags are created equal!

Yes, you can recycle plastic bags that are labeled with a recycling symbol on them, but no, you can't recycle bags without the label (such as sandwich bags, trash bags, etc.)

And please, **never place your recyclables inside a trash bag!** Unlike your regular trash, recyclables must be sorted, so they should be placed loose inside a collection container. The only exceptions to this are shredded paper, which should be placed in a paper bag, and recyclable plastic bags, which should be gathered in a single plastic bag.

Too many recyclables?

If you find that you have more recyclable items than will fit in your cart, you can place them next to the cart in an open box or paper bag, or tied up in a bundle.

If you regularly recycle a lot, consider a free upgrade to a larger cart; the largest size available is a 95-gallon cart, which provides 30% more space than the standard cart. Simply call Allied Waste at 301-694-6498 or email your request to: frederickrecycles@republicservices.com
