When our town received the COVID relief funds better known as ARPA, one of the Burgess' and Town Council's top priorities was to help the town's business owners. The council opened an application process for 30 days and they had 6 business apply. All 6 were awarded \$5,000 dollars each. The Burgess and Town Council presented grant checks to the business owners at the 5/10/22 Town Council meeting. In addition to this the Town Council agreed to awarding \$3,500 each to the 6 non-profits in the town limits which include 4 churches, the American Legion and the Woodsboro Volunteer Fire Company.
